#### FROM THE PARISH PRIEST

The Feast of the Holy Family fittingly takes the place of the Sunday in the Octave of Christmas. The entrance antiphon recalls that God the Son, in becoming man, makes His *home* on earth. He takes to Himself the natural human loyalty and affection of a family, and gives obedience and devotion to His human parents. We are reminded that the family is the "Church in the Home", in which we first learn the ways of the Faith: our prayers and the richness of loving human relationships. The family bond reflects in a way the life of the Blessed Trinity as a communion of Persons bound together in an unbreakable unity of love. In His family, Our Lord learnt love and self-sacrifice, the very qualities that prepared Him for His Public Ministry and the Work of our Redemption.

#### MARY, THE MOTHER OF GOD

Although we are used to thinking of Our Blessed Lady as the Mother of God, and honouring her as such, we must remember that there was a time in the history of the Church when certain theologians denied that Mary was God's Mother. They were prepared to allow that she was Mother of Christ the Lord, but claimed that she could not be, nor could any human person be, the Mother of Almighty God. But the Church constantly believes otherwise, and at the Council of Ephesus in the year

431 A.D. the Bishops of the Universal Church met together to decree solemnly that the faith of the Church from the time of the Apostles has always been that Our Blessed Lady is indeed the "God-bearer" or, in Greek, the "Theotókos". To celebrate this definition, Pope Liberius built a magnificent Church in Rome to honour Mary the Mother of God, the Church we still know today as "St. Mary Major", adorned with beautiful ancient mosaics depicting the role of the Mother of God and the Old Testament prophecies fulfilled in her. The Roman Church from those times has honoured "The Mother of God" on January 1st.

#### FEASTS OF THE WEEK:

**St Basil & St Gregory of Nazianzus** were friends who studied together in Athens and both became bishops and Doctors (teachers) of the Church; Basil in Caesarea and Gregory in Nazianzus, both of which are in Cappadocia in modern-day Turkey.

The Most Holy Name of Jesus celebrates the meaning of the Name of our Saviour: "God saves", the name which was given to Him by the Angel Gabriel at the Annunciation (Lk 1:31) and also communicated to St. Joseph in the dream which God sent him to assure him of Our Lady's innocence (Mt 1:21).

#### PRE-AUTHORIZED GIVING PLAN (PAG)

PAG allows parishioners to make their **regular Sunday offering, Renovation fund** and if they wish their **ShareLife offering** using the direct debit system. PAG is an option, not a requirement. It is widely used in the Toronto Archdiocese and we want to make PAG available to all parishioners who would like to take advantage of it.

When you participate in pre-authorized giving, your offering is withdrawn from your account once a month on or about the 20th day of each month and deposited into the parish account.

If you are enrolled in our PAG (Pre-Authorized Giving) you will still be getting a box of envelopes for next year. Please continue to drop your offertory envelope in the basket – just write PAG across it before placing it in the basket. This way we encourage each other to support our parish and continue to teach our children the value of Christian stewardship. Also, the colored envelopes in your boxed sets for special collections are not included in PAG. Continue to use your special collections envelopes at their designated dates. Thank you for your continuous support of our parish needs!

**SANCTUARY LAMP:** the lamp hanging in the sanctuary, when lit, indicates the Real Presence of Christ, Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity, reserved in the Tabernacle (the veil of the Tabernacle indicates the same reality). The flickering light is also a sign of the prayers of the faithful which remain after they have left the parish church. This is the whole purpose of votive lights, which we have before images of the Sacred Heart, Our Lady, St Joseph, etc. The suggested offering is \$20.00.
