FROM THE PARISH PRIEST

Jesus, I trust in You!

On this Sunday, the Octave (8th) Day of Easter, the Gospel directs us to three important facts. First, since our Lord rose from the dead on a Sunday and appeared to His Apostles both on that Sunday and again on the following Sunday, He Himself has consecrated Sunday above all other days as the Christian Holy Day of the week and as the "day of meeting" between Himself and His followers. Secondly, Our Lord on the first Easter Day breathes the Holy Spirit into His Apostles. This is not the same outpouring as that still to come at Pentecost, which will be upon all Christian souls, but here it is specifically upon the souls of Christ's ministers for the forgiveness of the sins of others. Thirdly, Our Lord calls upon St. Thomas to turn away from doubt and unbelief, and to put his faith and trust in Him. Trust, belief and faith are closely connected. Our Lord deliberately did not reveal Himself to the whole world, but only to those whom He had chosen to be His followers. He allowed St. Thomas to be absent at the time of His first appearance to the Apostles so that Thomas's doubting, so tre nchantly expressed, should encourage the faith of countless Christians down the ages to come: "Unless I can put my finger into the wounds..." As Our Lord said to him: "Thomas, you believe because you have seen me; blessed are those who have not seen and still believe!" To believe in Our Lord risen from the dead is to trust in Him. It is to believe not only that He rose again, but why He needed to die and then to rise from the dead. "in the body He was put to death; in the spirit He was raised to life", St. Paul teaches us. Not that this implies that Our Lord was not raised bodily—no!—His risen state is truly bodily—that is why Thomas can be invited to put his fingers and hand into the wounds. But that His risen body transcends the ordinary limits of our bodily state—being confined to one place and time. Our Lord invites us all to trust in Him on this Feast of Divine Mercy because His death and resurrection have brought about new life for all who believe in Him; we are no longer confined to the selfishness of sin. We are now invited to "be merciful as your heavenly Father is merciful". For God the Father is, as St. Paul says to the Ephesians "rich in mercy", and we can rejoice that this mercy obliterates our sins. On this Sunday, the anniversary of the second Sunday of the Christian era, we are invited by Our Lord Himself, through His servant St. Faustina, to trust in Him. In order to receive the incomparable gift of God's mercy in Christ, we too must show that mercy to others. Today let us take advantage of this wonderful gift of mercy!

Together with Fr Tom, the deacons and parish staff I wish you all a Blessed Eastertide.

Monday is the feast of the Lord's Annunciation, transferred from 25th March. An additional Mass will be offered at 7:00pm.

The Annunciation is the Solemnity of the Incarnation, the moment that Our Blessed Lady virginally conceived the Son of God in her womb. As she heard the Angel's greeting, "Hail, full of grace!" she pondered what this could mean. "Fear not, Mary, for you will conceive and bear a Son." And Mary gave her consent: "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. Let it be done to me according to your word".

St Stanislaus (1030-79) Bishop of Cracow in Poland, he excommunicated King Boleslaus, known as "the cruel" on account of his immoral life, whereupon the King slew the saint with his own hand during the celebration of Holy Mass.

St Martin I: He was elected Pope in 649 and shortly after, convened a Council and excommunicated the Emperor Constans II on the grounds of heresy. In response, the emperor ordered that the Pope be tried for treason in Constantinople and in 654 he was condemned to death, a sentence commuted to life imprisonment. He was exiled to the Crimea and died three months later of starvation.

Easter! Resurrection and new life; a new life shared from an earthen tomb. This has been the meaning of life for Christian people for two thousand years. There is nothing more secure, nothing more lasting. Come and share the thrill of proclaiming this truth through your life as a priest, religious or deacon. Call Fr. 
