#### FROM THE PARISH PRIEST

#### EASTERTIDE AND OUR LADY

There is a beautiful link between the season of Eastertide and Our Lady. The month of May which is around the corner, Cardinal Newman wrote, virtually always falls entirely within Eastertide, and ushers in the summer with its early promise of flowers and sunshine to come. From this fact he draws the parallel with Our Lady who brings into the world our Lord and Saviour, and who in her own character and holiness prepares the way for Him. She is like the dawn of the new day of grace and life after the long night of sin brought upon us by our first parents. She is like this month of the year which is filled with signs of the summer which is almost here, and which has so many beauties of its own to delight us, just like Our Lady herself. Easter is above all other seasons the time of rejoicing, of anticipating the everlasting joys of heaven. After the rigours of Lent, a time of trial which exactly matches this life of testing and sometimes painful growth in holiness, Easter perfectly represents total enjoyment. Our Lord has won eternal life for all His brothers and sisters, who, like Him, are children of Adam and Eve. Our Lady is the first of those whom He has redeemed. She represents all that we are called to be when finally made

perfect in heaven, though of course even in that state of perfect bliss she will be pre-eminent over all angels and saints. Since Eastertide is above all other seasons the one in which we begin to live the joy of heaven, it is fitting that in Eastertide we honour Our Lady's image here on earth, just as we hope one day to be able to honour her in person when, by God's grace, we reach heaven. In heaven she is crowned Queen by the hand of her own Son, For insofar as we honour Our Lady we both please her Son, who delights to see His Mother honoured, and also we increase in grace; because nobody who gives due honour to Mary can fail to be drawn closer to her divine Son.

#### FEASTS OF THE WEEK:

#### St Marie de L'Incarnation

The first missionary woman to the New World, Marie was born in Tours, France, in 1599. Marie died in Quebec in 1672. She was beatified in 1980 and canonized in 2014.

**St Joseph the Worker** We honour St Joseph on this 'Labour Day', as the Patron Saint of the dignity and value of human work.

**St Pius V** (**1504-72**) Elected Pope in 1566, he remained a devout mendicant Dominican in his personal life. His Pontificate is marked by his defence of Church teachings, the excommunication of Elizabeth I, restoring of discipline to lax clergy and his insistence on strict adherence to the decrees of the Council of Trent.

**St Athanasius (296-373)** Much of his 46 years as Bishop of Alexandria was spent in exile due to opposition to his fierce stand against Arianism. Cardinal Newman, who had a particular devotion to him, described him as "...that extraordinary man...a principal instrument after the apostles by which the sacred truths of Christianity have been conveyed and secured to the world."

Sts Philip & James were two of the Apostles. Philip came from Bethsaida in Galilee and is mentioned both in St. John's Gospel and in the Acts of the Apostles (8:4 ff. And 8:26 ff.) In the Gospel we are told that he said to Our Lord at the Last Supper "Show us the Father and we shall be satisfied", to which Our Lord replied, "Have you been with me so long, Philip and still you do not know me? to see me is to see the Father." James is also known as "the Less" to distinguish him from the brother of St. John. Nonetheless, this St. James wrote the New Testament Letter which bears his name and which teaches the importance of Good Works as the fruit and expression of living faith.

**Bl Marie-Leonie Paradis** was born at L'Acadie, Quebec, in 1840. At Memramcook, New Brunswick, she founded, in 1880, the Little Sisters of the Holy Family dedicated to the service of the priesthood. In 1895, upon request of Bishop Paul Larocque, the community was transferred to Sherbrooke, Quebec. At the times of Mother Leonie's death in 1912, the Little Sisters of the Holy Family served in forty houses in Canada and the United States. While visiting Canada in 1984, Pope John Paul II beatified Mother Mary Leonie in Montreal on 11th September.


