FROM THE PARISH PRIEST

JUNE IS THE MONTH DEDICATED TO THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

On 8 June we celebrated the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Its date is determined by when Easter falls; therefore it is a movable feast. The feast acts as a reminder to us all of the immense love that Jesus Christ has for all of us—a love that took Him to the Cross in order to bring us the gift of eternal life. Margaret Mary Alacoque was a nun of the Visitation Order in France. In December 1673 she began to receive a series of revelations from the Sacred Heart of Jesus which were to last for eighteen months. The chief elements of the messages she was to make known was the establishment of the feast itself. In one of the visions, Our Lord made known to Saint Margaret Mary the following desire: "I ask that the first Friday after the octave of Corpus Christi be dedicated in a special feast in honour of my heart, in reparation for the indignities It has suffered while exposed on altars." This message stood in stark contrast to the teachings of Jansenism which was so rife in seventeenth century

France. Condemned as a heresy, Jansenism advocated that we are predestined for salvation or damnation despite our efforts to cooperate with God's grace. It was not until 1765, however, that the Sacred Heart devotion became fully recognised and was inserted into the calendar with its own proper Mass and Office. Let us strive to foster this wonderful devotion which makes us mindful of the graces that we have already received and opens us to receive still more. Let us do as Our Lord requests by observing the Nine First Fridays and keeping an image of the Sacred Heart in our homes that His loving presence may be with us and keep ourselves and our families in His loving care.

Father's Day: every blessing to our fathers and may our departed ones rest in the peace of the Lord.

FEASTS OF THE WEEK:

St Romuald (c.951-1027) Born at Ravenna he lived a worldly life until he witnessed his father kill a relative. He decided to atone for the crime as if he had committed it himself. He joined the Benedictines rising to Abbot. He sought to restore penance and solitude in monasticism, and after founding several monasteries, he founded the austere Order of Camaldoli in Tuscany.

St Aloysius Gonzaga (1568-91) His father was an Italian noble and soldier in the service of King Philip II, and Aloysius was expected to join the military. But he abhorred violence and at 17, received his father's permission to join the Jesuits. Soon after, plague broke out and he worked tirelessly caring for the sick, succumbing to illness from which he never fully recovered. Many attested to his holiness. He died at age 23.

St John Fisher (1459-1535) Bishop of Rochester and friend of Thomas More, he was the only one of the English Catholic bishops who refused to take the Oath of Supremacy, or to acknowledge Henry VIII's divorce from Catherine of Aragon.

St Thomas More (1478-1535) Chancellor of England and friend of the King's until their fall-out over Henry's divorce and the Oath of Supremacy, he died "...the King's good servant, but God's first". The Roman Martyrology says: "These two men were beheaded for the Catholic Faith and for the primacy of blessed Peter and the Bishop of Rome".
