### FROM THE PARISH PRIEST

**13th Sunday:** In the Old Testament reading for today's Mass, the writer of the book of Wisdom reflects on the story of Paradise lost by Adam and Eve's disobedience found in the Book of Genesis. He says, "*Yet God did make man imperishable, he made him in the image of his own nature; it was the devil's envy that brought death into the world ...*" Physical sickness, mental illness, stress and the effects of ageing are consequences of the Fall. Our natural human state was to be in the image and likeness of God. Since The Fall we are prey to disintegration and dysfunction. Humanity has departed from the norm. In Heaven, death, sin, and sickness have no place. An ancient Russian Orthodox chant for funerals says, "Give rest, O Christ, to thy servant with thy saints: where sorrow and pain are no more, neither sighing; but life everlasting." In the Church we have confidence that our bishops and priests have the power to forgive sins in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. In many ways Confession is a sacrament of healing. The Church also provides the Sacrament of the Sick, whose effects are similar. We can ask for the Sacrament of the Sick in times of serious illness: before surgery or major treatment, at the onset of a progressive illness, when we have a physical or mental crisis. We do not have to be dying. However, the sacrament is not for colds or toothache. Our approach to the sacrament is an approach to Our Lord Himself, and so must done in faith.

### FEASTS OF THE WEEK:

**St Thomas** One of the Twelve, known as "*Didymus*" (Greek for *twin*), his scepticism vanished at the sight of Our Lord's wounds. After Pentecost, he travelled to Asia Minor and eventually reached the Malabar Coast in India which still boasts a large Catholic population in Kerala calling themselves "Christians of St Thomas". He was martyred at Calamine.

**St Elizabeth of Portugal (1271-1336)** Despite a troublesome marriage, she lived a life of prayer and cared for the needy founding hospitals, orphanages and a women's refuge. She used her position as Queen of Portugal to broker peace between nations. After her husband died she went to assist at a Poor Clares' convent she had established.

**St Anthony Mary Zaccaria (1502-39)** He became a priest having been a doctor, and moved to Milan to the church of St Barnabas and in 1530 he co-founded the Barnabites, a congregation under the patronage of St Paul and, in particular, his preaching relating to the Holy Eucharist.

**St Maria Goretti (1890-1902)** Born in Nettuno, between Rome and Naples, she was known for her kindness and devotion. She was murdered (when only twelve) for refusing to succumb to her next-door neighbour when he raped her. What was more important, however, was her forgiveness of her attacker. Not only did she forgive him as she lay dying in hospital, but after her death, her unrepentant attacker was visited by Maria in a dream and when he awoke, he was a changed man. He was present at her Canonisation in 1950.
