FROM THE PARISH PRIEST

The Sunday Gospel: Mark 10:17-30

Today in the Gospel we heard of a man who had no name. At least, no name that history records. Why not? Why do the Gospel writers not know who he is? Presumably, because he went away and never came back. A tragedy. If we think about why he left, as we heard, he left sad. If we think about why he was sad, it was because the Lord Jesus said he had to choose between his riches, and, following the Lord. And to not follow Jesus leaves the soul sad. He was a "rich young man", he had his whole life ahead of him. And that life, it seems, was a life of sadness because he chose riches over the Lord. What of us? If we are attached like the rich young man, then we will feel sad when we are prompted to anything that disrupts our attachments. If we are detached like Levi, we will be prompt and eager to leave what must be left to follow. If we are detached like Zacchaeus, then even though we possess things, we will only hold them lightly, because our joy in the Lord, in finding more joy in possessing Him than we do in possessing things, will leave us free to give, free to love, and free to give in a way that causes us to have joy, not sadness, in our heart.

FEASTS OF THE WEEK

St Teresa (1515-82) Born in Avila of a wealthy family, she joined the Carmelites. She was very concerned with the state of the Order, and amongst great opposition, she set about its reform with the help of the mystical poet-priest, St John of the Cross. A mystic herself, her books are still clearly readable, simple and profound aids to prayer.

St Marguerite d'Youville (1701-1771)The first Canadian-born person to be canonized, this French Canadian founded the religious order, the Sisters of Charity of Montreal, commonly known as the "Grey Nuns." St John XXIII called her the "Mother of Universal Charity." Canonized by St John Paul II in 1990, her shrine is in Varennes, near Montreal.

St Ignatius of Antioch (d. c.107) A disciple of St Peter before becoming Bishop of Antioch, he was captured and sent to Rome and martyrdom. On his journey, he wrote seven important letters which recount the Church's life and thought in those times.

St Luke (1st cent.) was the only one of the writers of the Scriptures who we know was a Gentile, ie a non-Jew. He was a Greek physician and a follower of St Paul. He wrote the third Gospel and the Acts of the Apostles, which tells of the early growth of the Church and preaching of the Gospel throughout the Roman world after Pentecost.

St Paul of the Cross (d. 1775) was the founder of the Passionist Congregation.

St Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647-90) In visions she received from Our Lord, He requested the spread of devotion to His Sacred Heart as the symbol of His love for us.

If we really believe in something, it does not seem to be a sacrifice to give up everything else to pursue that new dream. Jesus asks the same as any great leader...total dedication; but He promises rewards no one else can promise. "You will have treasure in Heaven, then come, follow Me."
