FEASTS OF THE WEEK **THE POPE'S CATHEDRAL CHURCH**

Friday's feast known generally as the "*Dedication of the Lateran Basilica*" recalls the Dedication of the Pope's Cathedral Church in Rome, or, to give it its full title, the *Archbasilica of Our Saviour and Sts. John the Baptist and John the Evangelist*. It is popularly known as "the Lateran Basilica" after the noble Roman family of the "Laterani" who gave the land to Pope St. Silvester, the first Pope to reign after the end of the great centuries of persecution. Here the Pope was at last able openly to establish his home and Cathedral Church. A consecrated Church building is a symbol of Christ, and of His Body, the Church built up of living stones. In any diocese, the Cathedral is the Mother Church, because it is the place where the Bishop celebrates the Liturgy and from which he directs the local Church placed under his care by Christ, the Good Shepherd. In the case of the Cathedral of Rome, however, we are considering the Church from which the Bishop of Rome, the Pope, presides as Supreme Pastor over the entire Catholic world. The Lateran Basilica, the "*Archbasilica of Our Saviour*", is therefore a powerful sign of the unity of the Church on earth, focussed on the person successor of Peter, the Prince of the Apostles, upon whom Christ established the foundation and governance of His Church.

St Leo the Great (d. 461) A man of great ability, he profoundly influenced the course of the Church with his famous clarification of Our Lord's Person: His Divinity and manhood inseparably united, yet unmixed. Pope Leo was a man of great eloquence and did much to broker peace. He met with Attila the Hun, at the gates of Rome and persuaded him to turn back, and when the Vandals under Genseric occupied the city of Rome, he persuaded the invaders to desist from pillaging the city and harming its inhabitants. He died in 461, leaving many letters and writings of great historical importance.



As members of our Catholic community, we regularly benefit from the tireless service of our priests. Called by God and ordained to care for His people, our priests serve our families, in churches, schools, hospitals, nursing homes, missions and on the streets. The Shepherds' Trust ensures our priests can live their retirement years with dignity.
