## FEASTS OF THE WEEK

**St Josaphat** of Polotsk was raised an Ukranian Orthodox but became a monk in the Ruthenian rite, which was united with Rome. As Bishop, he worked hard for the whole of the Orthodox Church to be re-united under the authority of the Pope, but the opposition to his work in the Eastern Church led to his martyrdom.

**St Albert the Great** was a German who belonged to the earliest generation of the Order of Preachers (Dominicans) and both studied and taught in Paris and Cologne. He was a notable theologian and, most important for the subsequent development of science and learning, he was an outstanding student of natural science, basing his method on careful observation of facts and natural phenomena, and formulating penetrating questions for investigation and study. He was a great teacher and among his pupils was St. Thomas Aquinas. He was eventually appointed Bishop of Ratisbon in Southern Germany. He is a Doctor of the Church.

**St Margaret of Scotland** married Malcolm of Scotland and was renowned for her acts of piety and great love of the poor. She reformed abuses prevalent at the time, and promoted education and the arts.

**St Gertrude** (1227-1301) A mystic, she had great devotion to the Sacred Heart which she fostered throughout the Church by her writings, still highly recommended.

**St Elizabeth of Hungary (1207-31)** Widowed at the age of twenty, she became a Franciscan Tertiary and devoted the remainder of her short life to charitable works.
