FROM THE PARISH PRIEST

Christ the King: The last Sunday of the Church's year corresponds to the End of Time. In the Creed we proclaim that "He (Christ) will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and His kingdom will have no end." "Thus we remind ourselves that, one day, the world as we know it will end, and all human history will be brought to its climax and goal for which it was created, the unveiling of the glory of Him who is God's Son and Mary's, "True God and True Man." Then Christ will be "all in all" and all creation will serve Him in the light of unending glory. The origin of this feast, established by Pius XI in 1925, was to counteract, first, the growth of totalitarianism, which proclaimed the priority of the state over the person, disavowing the rights of the individual; and secondly, to teach ultimately that all authority comes from Christ.

FEAST OF THE WEEK

St Andrew (1st cent) He was the first Apostle and the older brother of St Peter. He evangelised Asia Minor and Greece, and was martyred by crucifixion in the position represented by the "X". In addition to Scotland, he is patron of Russia and Greece.

Throughout this month of November there is a **Book of Remembrance** located beside the statue of St. Joseph on the Sanctuary. You are invited to inscribe the names of those who have passed away and we will remember them during each Mass during the month of November.
