THIS WEEK THE SANCTUARY LAMP BURNS
IN MEMORY OF HENRY SLACZKA

SANCTUARY LAMP: the lamp hanging in the sanctuary, when lit, indicates the Real Presence of Christ, Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity, reserved in the Tabernacle (the veil of the Tabernacle indicates the same reality). The flickering light is also a sign of the prayers of the faithful which remain after they have left the parish church. This is the whole purpose of votive lights, which we have before images of the Sacred Heart, Our Lady, St Joseph, etc. The suggested offering is \$20.00.

FROM THE PARISH PRIEST

Second Sunday of the year: This week we complete this series of epiphanies of Christ by recalling the very first miracle that Jesus worked, at the wedding feast at Cana. So, what does His first miracle manifest about Jesus? As we sing in, “Songs of thankfulness and praise”, in this event He is “manifest in power divine, changing water into wine”. The point very simply is this: in His appearing has revealed Himself to be a God of power, a God who DOES things. The miracle at Cana, the start of His “public life” (as we call it), manifested what would be a pattern throughout His public life: He worked miracles, God’s power was displayed. He gave sight to the blind, health to the sick, He opened the ears of the deaf, He raised the dead, and He crowned all these displays of divine power by His own rising from the dead, three days after His crucifixion.

FEASTS OF THE WEEK

St Agnes: Mentioned in the Roman Canon, she was martyred c. 304, at the age of twelve for her Christianity and for refusing to give up her virginity, which she had consecrated to God.

St Vincent (d. 304), the proto-martyr of Spain. He was arrested with the Bishop of Sargossa, during the persecution by Spain’s governor, Dacian, and tortured by being roasted on a grid iron, and then left to die in a prison cell full of broken pottery.

St Francis de Sales (1567-1622) A French nobleman, he became Bishop of Geneva, a Calvinist stronghold. He was renowned for his sensitivity and kindness to others, good manners and gentleness in judgement which meant he was highly thought of even by his enemies. A Calvinist minister said of him: “If we honour any man as a saint, I know no one since the days of the Apostles more worthy of it than this man.”

The Conversion of St Paul: We commemorate the dramatic events at the gates of Damascus when Saul, the Pharisee and persecutor of Christians, was struck from his horse and heard Our Lord’s voice calling to him: “Saul, why are you persecuting me?”

St Timothy & St Titus (1st century) Timothy was Bishop of Ephesus and Titus of Crete and both were disciples of St Paul. In three of his letters, St Paul tells them of their responsibilities as Bishops, ie successors and co-workers of the Apostles.
