#### **FROM THE PARISH PRIEST**

**The Beatitudes:** Today's Gospel is St. Luke's account of the teaching of the "Beatitudes", by Our Lord. These are short phrases in which He declares the blessedness of those who suffer now, because they will receive a reward in compensation for their present difficulties. By contrast, He proclaims the "woe" of those who are prosperous or fortunate now, for deprivation will come upon them. In this way Our Lord teaches us not to associate present good fortune with God's blessings, nor to assume that poverty, hunger and sorrow are signs of God's anger or curse upon those who suffer them. Such had been the common assumption of people in Our Lord's day. He now turns that idea upside down.

#### **FEASTS OF THE WEEK**

**The Chair of St Peter:** Today's feast dates back to the fourth century and celebrates the unity of the Catholic Church around the primacy of St Peter, the Prince of the Apostles and his successors. The "Chair" is a symbol of teaching authority (as with professors in our universities). We recall that Our Lord gave St Peter authority among the Apostles to "strengthen his brothers in the Faith". (*St Luke's Gospel, ch 22 v 32*).

**St Polycarp** (d.155) As a young man, he had known St John and 'others who had seen the Lord'. He became Bishop of Smyrna and was an old man when betrayed by a servant and taken before the pro-consul. He refused to denounce Our Lord saying: I have served Him for eighty-six years. How can I blaspheme my God and Saviour?" He was sentenced to be burned alive, but miraculously, the flames formed an arch around him "like a ship's sail filled with the wind", and the executioner was ordered to stab him. The account of his martyrdom, written at the time, survives today.

Happy are those who know they need God. Happy too those who live faithfully the vocation of the life-commitment God calls them to, be it married, single, religious or priesthood.
