FEASTS OF THE WEEK

Our Lady of Fatima: In 1917, Our Lady appeared on six consecutive occasions, from May to October, to three shepherd children in Fatima, at a small place called the *Cova d' Iria* (Cave of Peace) She exhorted that people make sacrifices, do penance, and pray for world peace and the conversion of sinners. Referring to herself as the "Lady of the Rosary", she particularly urged that we should all say the Rosary every day.

St Matthias: He was elected by the Apostles, by lot, to replace Judas Iscariot. He had been a follower of Our Lord and of the Apostles and was a witness to the truth of the Resurrection. He was also present at the Descent of the Holy Spirit on Our Lady and the Apostles at Pentecost.

St John I (d. 526) His short pontificate was largely taken up by peace negotiations between the Eastern Emperor and the Gothic King who ultimately imprisoned the Pope at Ravenna where he died.

On this Good Shepherd Sunday we celebrate the World Day of Prayer for Vocations. Pray for an increase in vocations to the priesthood, diaconate, and religious life, especially for our diocese, that God will raise up good shepherds in our midst.
