Dear Father,

Cardinal Newman, who was canonized on October 13, took as his motto as a Cardinal: *cor ad cor loquitur* – heart speaks to heart.

Rather, it's the love we demonstrate through a heartfelt personal encounter, through which our neighbour physically experiences the love of the Lord God in our midst.
