**PRE-AUTHORIZED GIVING PLAN (PAG)**

PAG allows parishioners to make their **regular Sunday offering, Renovation fund** and if they wish their **ShareLife offering** using the direct debit system. PAG is an option, not a requirement. It is widely used in the Toronto Archdiocese and we want to make PAG available to all parishioners who would like to take advantage of it.

When you participate in pre-authorized giving, your offering is withdrawn from your account once a month on or about the 20th day of each month and deposited into the parish account.

If you are enrolled in our PAG (Pre-Authorized Giving) **you will still be getting a box of envelopes for next year. Please continue to drop your empty offertory envelope in the basket – just write PAG across it before placing it in the basket.** This way we encourage each other to support our parish and continue to teach our children the value of Christian stewardship. Also, **the colored envelopes in your boxed sets for special collections are not included in PAG. Continue to use your special collections envelopes at their designated dates.** Thank you for your continuous support of our parish needs!
